

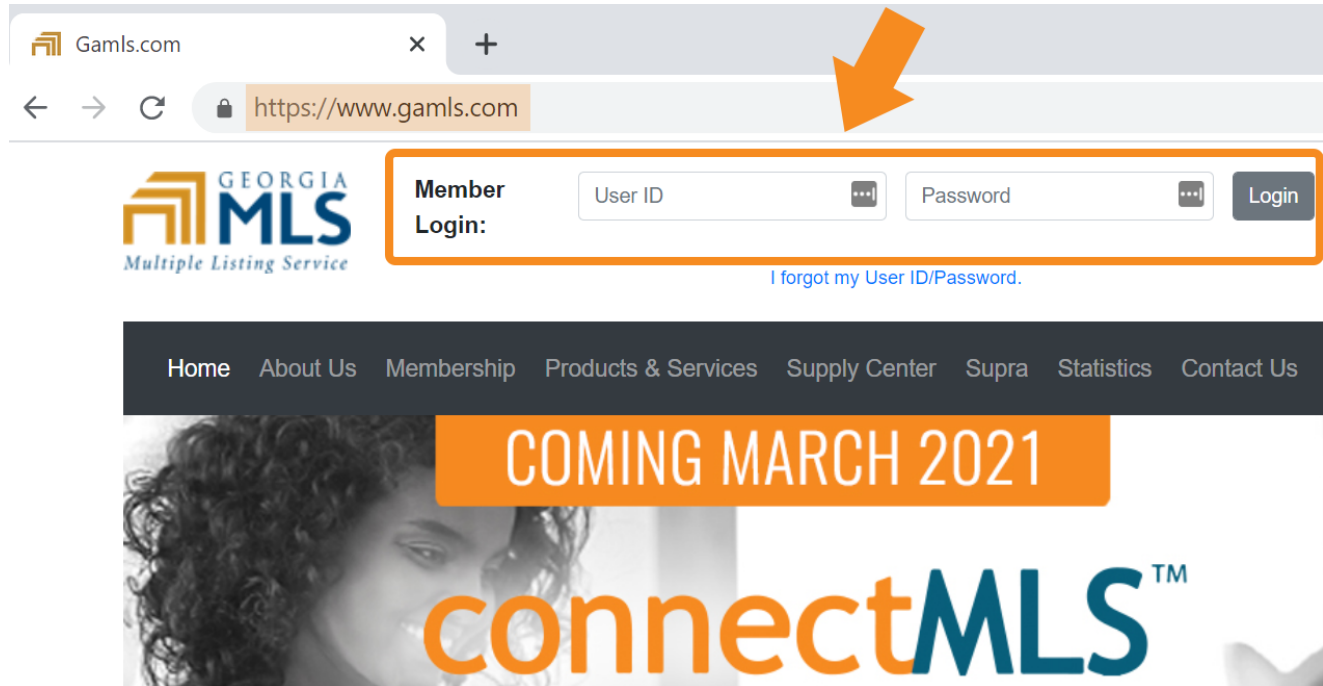

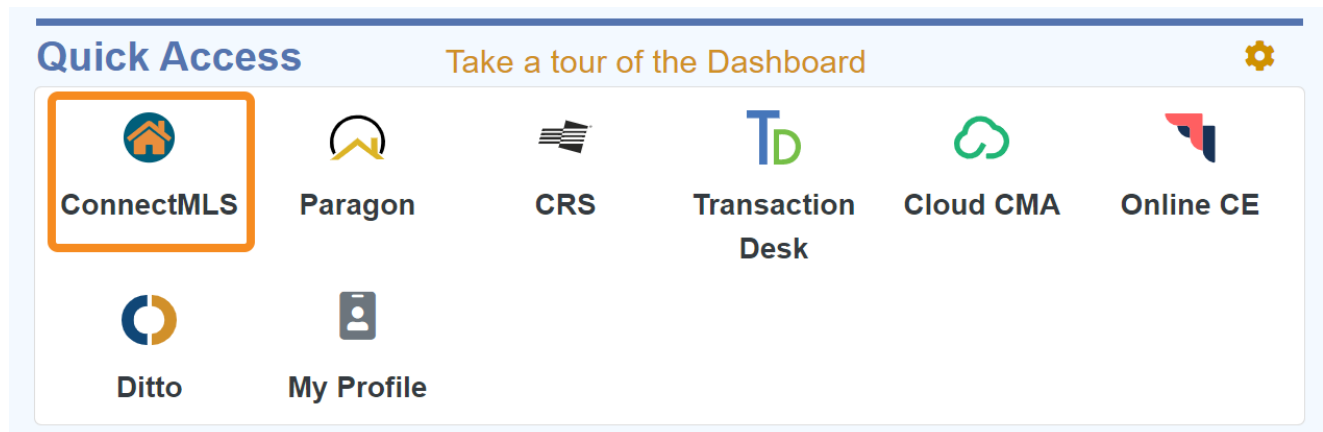

Signing into connectMLS

To access **connectMLS**, navigate to www.gamls.com and enter your **Member Login** information, and select **Login**.




Select the **connectMLS** icon from the list of available **Quick Access** features.

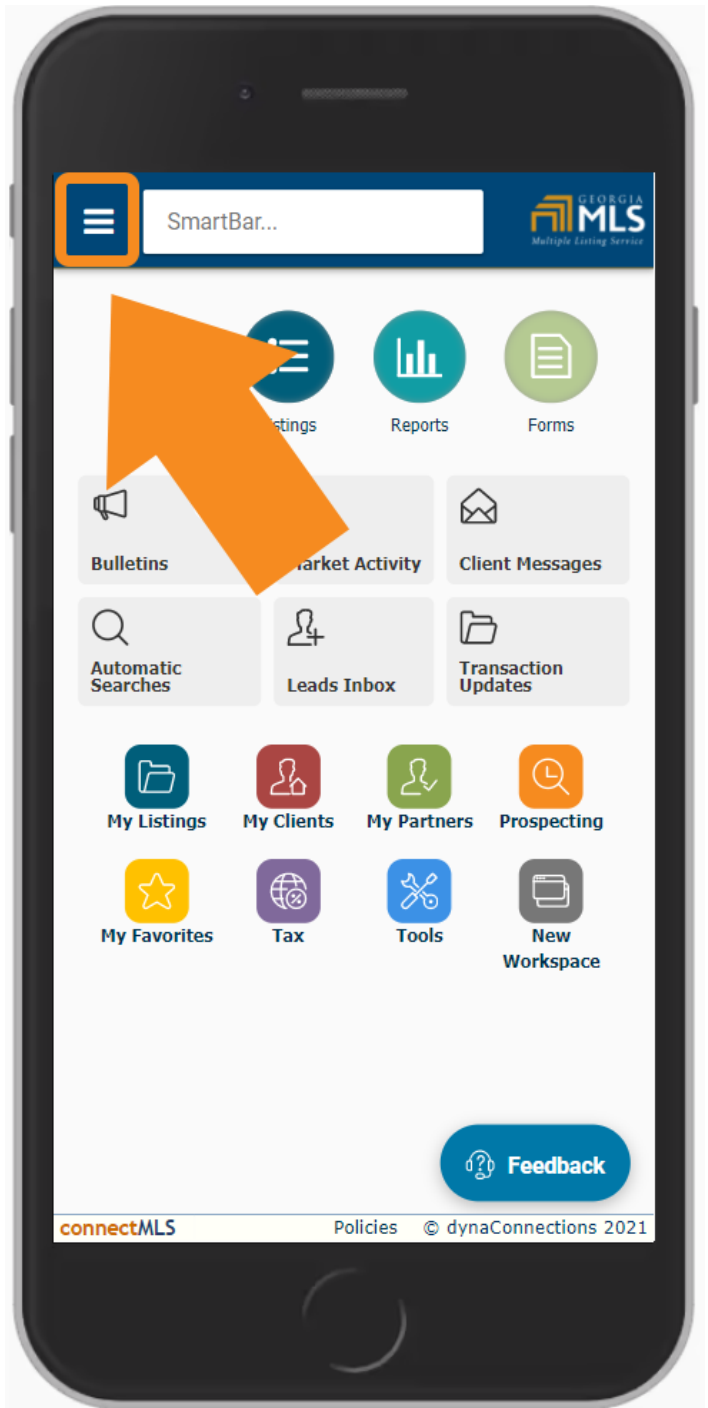

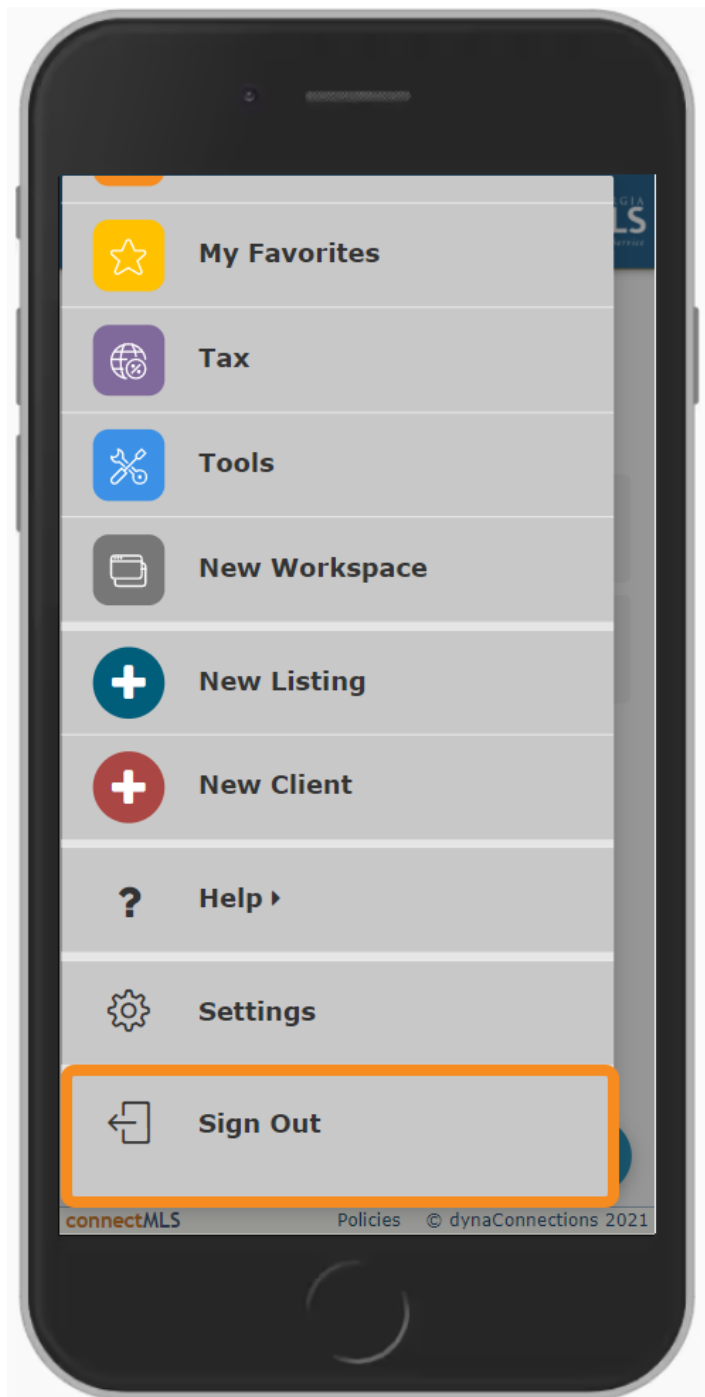
